1. **Rules.** The race will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the FSSA Class Rules, and the Sailing Instructions.

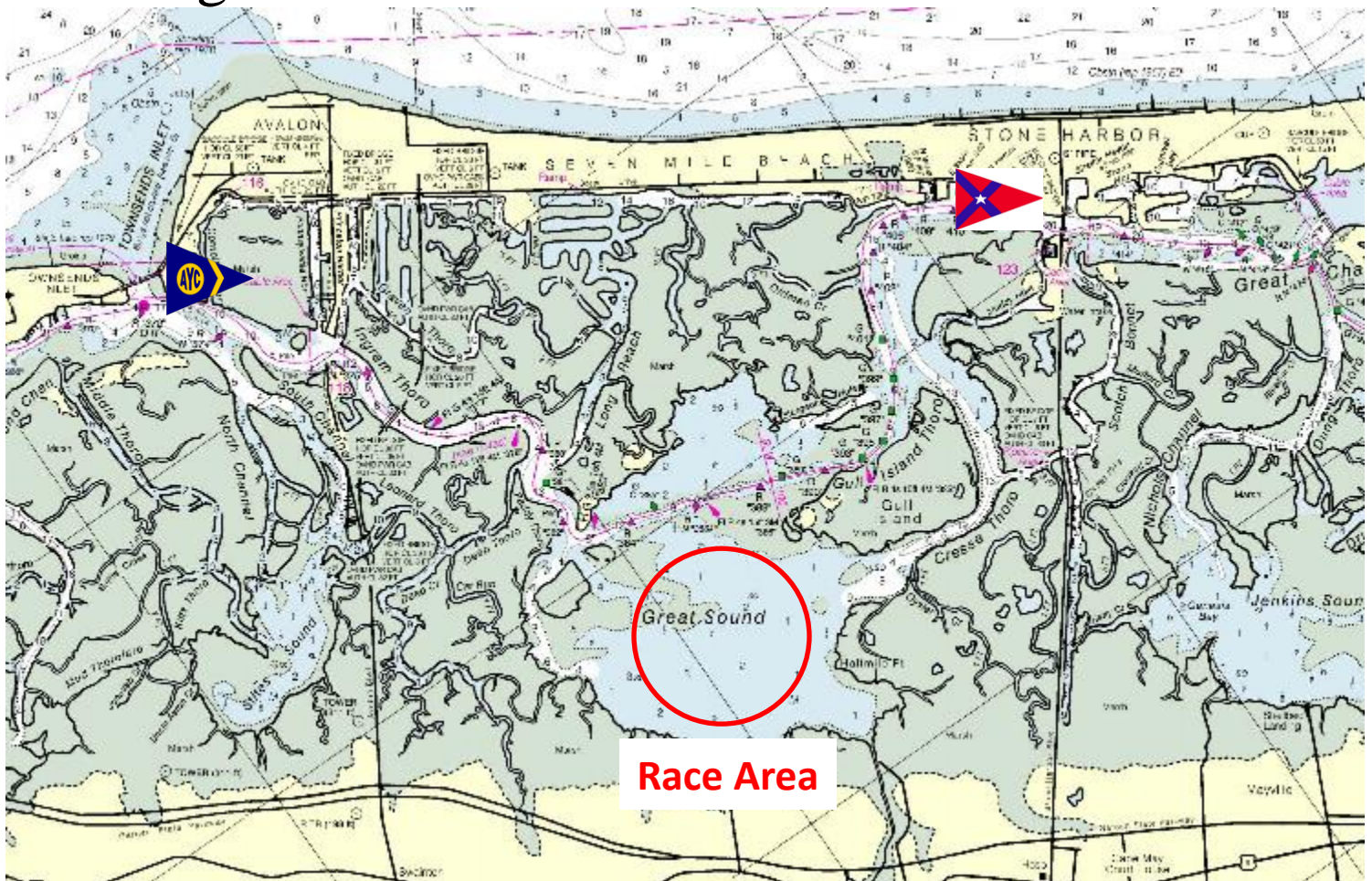
