Lake Murray Sailing Club (LMSC) and Flying Scot Fleet 158, located on beautiful Lake Murray, invite you to participate in our annual *Scots on the Rocks* regatta. Part of the **Carolina's District Helmhold Series**, we are also proud to host our **2017 Carolina's District Championship** at this year's event.

Open to all currently registered FSSA members, the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and FSSA rules will govern this regatta except as amended by regatta sailing instructions. Sailing instructions will be available at the registrar's desk on the day of registration. Scoring will be the Low Point System as described in Appendix "A" of the RRS. We are planning five scheduled races for the series. One race, however, shall constitute a regatta and all races will be scored. Trophies will be awarded to the top three skippers and crew and a trophy will be awarded to the top skipper and crew of the youth division.

We offer free on-site camping, proximity to hotels, excellent clubhouse facilities and wonderful down home" hospitality. Please refer to our website, <http://www.lmsc.org/flying-scots/scots-on-the-rocks>, for Regatta Registration, directions to LMSC, and local hotel information.

As a courtesy, the Race Committee will provide information to competitors on a channel to be designated at the Competitor's Meeting.

Competitors are encouraged to track races each day with the smartphone app *RaceQs*. Races will be streamed live for spectators at <http://raceqs.com/regattas/59271>, however no competitor may use live streaming to gain competitive advantage until racing is done for the day. Further instructions may be provided at the competitors meeting.

The club will be open at 12:00 PM Friday September 1st for guests who wish arrive early to set up camp or park boats before retiring to the hotel.

A catered BBQ Dinner will be provided Saturday evening. Lunches for Saturday may be purchased. A Complimentary continental breakfast will be available Saturday and Sunday. Sunday lunch will be complimentary.
