NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013 2016 edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and as modified by the Sailing Instructions. The organizing authority is the Sailing Club of Washington.
- The Sailing Instructions will be made available on the website www.SCOW.org at least
 2 days prior to the event and at registration.
- 3. Advertising: There are no restrictions on advertising
- 4. Eligibility: In order to enter this event you must be:
 - a Leukemia & Lymphoma Society donor and registered with the LLS as a participant. You must register at <u>http://www.leukemiacup.org/pages/nca/nca15</u>

Competitors will be required to sign a statement saying "I agree to be bound by The Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event."

- Classes: This regatta is for Flying Scots. Other one design dinghy classes may enter and any class with 4 or more boats will be started separately. Classes with less than 4 boats will be started together and scored using the Portsmouth Yard Stick scoring system.
- 6. Boat launching: Boats can be launched at the Washington Sailing Marina by prior arrangement directly with the Marina (<u>http://www.washingtonsailingmarina.com/</u>). Public free launching facilities and parking for boat trailers is available at Gravelly Point which is immediately adjacent to the course area.
- Schedule: On-site registration and Skippers bags pick up and will be on Friday September 11, 2015, 6:00pm – 8:00 pm behind the marina store and Saturday September 12, 2015 8:00am – 9:00 am on the Potomac Belle spectator boat berthed at WSM.

- The **Regatta Kick-off Party** will take place from 6:00pm to 8:00pm on Friday September 11, 2015
- **Skippers meeting** will be at 9:00 am at the picnic table immediately to the west of the dock cranes.
- The intent is to run at least three races on Saturday September 12th. First race starts at 12.00 pm. Races will be scored. The Race Committee may elect to cancel racing for any reason, including weather or safety.
- The **Regatta Post Race Party** begins at 3:00pm September 12, 2015. The band starts playing at 4:00pm.
- 8. **Measurement:** All SCOW owned boats are eligible. All entered must conform to their respective class association rules.
- Courses to be sailed: The courses to be sailed will be in the area between Reagan National Airport and Giesboro Point and will be described in the Sailing Instructions and designated by signs on the Race Committee boat.
- 10. **Scoring:** The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used. All races will be counted; there are no throw-outs.
- 11. **Awards:** Awards will be made by the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society after racing is complete and final scores have been determined by the Race Committee at the Post Race Party.
