

Notice of Race
JYC HOSPITALITY REGATTA
October 26-27, 2019



The Jackson Yacht Club (“JYC”) is pleased to invite all interested sailors to compete in the Hospitality Regatta be held at the Jackson Yacht Club located at 700 Yacht Club Road, Ridgeland, MS 39157. Racing will take place on the Ross Barnett Reservoir adjacent to the JYC.

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, including Appendix T, this Notice of Race and any modifications posted on the day of the race. RRS apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all boats. One-design entries of three or more shall constitute a separate class and may be started and/or scored separately as determined by the principle race officer (PRO). For any separate one-design fleet, all boats of that one-design class are required to sail with that fleet. All other entries shall be assigned to either PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker or Portsmouth handicap fleets as determined by the PRO. Assigned PHRF or Portsmouth Handicaps, the starting order, or assignment of fleets and classes are the sole decision of the PRO and cannot be protested.

4. REGISTRATION AND FEES

4.1. Registration may be accomplished by completing the attached registration form and submitting with payment of the entry fee. Additional forms may be obtained by calling JYC at 601-856-8844 or picked up at the registration desk upon arrival.

4.2. Regatta Entry Fee, all classes and boats: \$40.00.

4.3. The entry fee may be paid in one of the following ways: By check made payable to Jackson Yacht Club, or by cash, check, or credit card at the registration desk prior to the Skippers Meeting. JYC members may charge the fee to their accounts.

4.4. JYC entry fee includes skipper and all crew for Saturday and Sunday’s continental breakfast.

4.5. Box lunch (Saturday only) will be available for pickup at Saturday breakfast \$6.00. Saturday dinner/Sunday lunch is available from the menu at menu prices or from the Sunday Buffet.

6. RACES

6.1. One Design, Multihull and Flying Scott class

6.1.1. Five (5) races are planned for the Regatta. In the event the wind is more favorable on Saturday than is forecast for Sunday, a fourth race may be sailed on Saturday.

6.2. PHRF Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker

6.2.1. Three (3) races are planned for the Regatta—two on Saturday and one on Sunday. In the event the wind is more favorable on Saturday than is forecast for Sunday, a third race may be sailed on Saturday.

6.3. Club 420 Fleet - See Sailing Instructions

6.4. One race shall constitute the regatta for all classes and fleets.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and Registration desk at the JYC club house.

8. SCORING

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. There will be no scores excluded. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A4 will apply. Penalty system Rule 44.1 shall also apply.

9. TROPHIES

9.1. Trophies to be awarded downstairs at the conclusion of Sunday's races.

9.1.1. One Design, Multihull & PHRF – 1st and 2nd place finishers in each class.

9.1.2. Flying Scot Fleet – District Championship Medals to be awarded to 1st thru 3rd place Skipper and Crew.

9.1.3. High School Fleet – See Sailing Instructions

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material or boat damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.
