Blackbeard Sailing Club cordially invites all one-design sailboats to attend the Blackbeard, UnionBank One-Design Regatta. Classes attending may include: Buccaneer, Ensign, Flying Scot, Isotope, Laser, Lightning, Optimist, San Juan 21, Sunfish, Tanzer 16, Thistle etc and Open.

1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing. Appendix V1 will be invoked by the Sailing Instructions*
2. **Classes:** This is a regatta for one-design mono-hull sailboats. **Four boats of one design, registered by August 19 2018, shall constitute a class. Other boats will race in a combined class and be scored via the Portsmouth Yardstick.**
3. **Registration:** ***Pre-registration will be online and is highly recommended. See the link below. The entry fee for preregistration is \$40*** and includes two meals for Saturday evening. US Sailing members may deduct \$5.00 and must provide their USSailing member number.
 - b. Late Registration commences at 8:00 PM on Sunday August 19th and runs through 8:00 AM August 25th (race day) for an additional fee of \$10.00. Please register early and save your hard earned money.
4. **Courses:** Race courses will be on the Neuse River or Broad Creek depending on conditions and will be formatted in either a triangle windward leeward or windward leeward.
5. **Sailing Instructions:** The sailing instructions will be available online (see link at bottom) on or before August 1, 2018 and also available for your convenience at the regatta.
6. **Schedule:**
 - Saturday, August 25, 2018:**
 - 08:00 AM Late Registration closes
 - 09:00 AM Competitors Meeting on the clubhouse deck.
 - 10:55 AM Warning Signal for the first race.
 - Sunday, August 26, 2018:**
 - 08:00 AM Coffee and donuts in the clubhouse
 - 09:55 AM First Warning Signal for first race, subsequent race(s) follow at the discretion of the R/C. No races to be started after 1:00 PM.
7. **Berthing:** If you wish to tow your one-design boat behind your big boat to Blackbeard and sleep on your big boat, a limited number of free slips are available at Blackbeard Sailing Club on a first-come, first-served basis. For details contact Blackbeard Sailing Club Dockmaster, Bill Drechsler at billhotchoc@hotmail.com . Please include your Length, Beam and Draft in the first email. A shuttle service for boats anchored in Upper Broad Creek also may be available. Flying Scot competitors may leave their boats at BSC until the FS ACC at their own risk.
8. **Lodging:**
 - a. Free camping is available on site at Blackbeard. The club's bathhouse is nearby.
 - b. Resort Management Group at Fairfield Harbour. These weekend rental units are less than a mile from the club. Contact Liza Redington at 252-638-8011 or guestservices@resortmgmtgroup.com . Gwen has units that sleep four and rent for around \$125/ - \$135 per night.
 - c. **Vacation Resorts International. These weekend rentals are also less than a mile from the Club. Contact Diana Morris or "Duffy" at 252-633-1151 or the harbour@suddenlink.com. They have units that sleep 8 and rent for around \$150 a night and may offer discounts to sailors.**
