- 8. Dry Berthing: Boats shall be kept on trailers in parking area.
- 9. <u>VHF Radios</u>: It is the intention of the Race Committee to utilize VHF communication in accordance with FSSA Specification S-V-7.
- 10. **Scoring:** The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used, except that there will be no throw-outs. 4 races are scheduled, of which one must be completed to constitute a series.
- 11. <u>Prizes</u>: Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in the Championship Division, and to the top 3 boats in Challenger Division, The George Balas Trophy will be awarded for First Place in the Championship Division.
