



NOTICE OF RACE 2022 Roger Punzi Memorial Regatta, Fleet 24 Championships & 2nd Leg CT Cup Candlewood Yacht Club October 8 and 9, 2022 Candlewood Yacht Club/Flying Scot Fleet 24 7 Shore Drive, New Fairfield, CT

<u>Rules:</u> This event shall be governed by the current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including the FSSA Class Rules. The applicable requirements in the Constitution, Bylaws, Specifications, Chief Measurer's Rulings, and Official Plan constitute the FSSA "Class Rules" as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

<u>Eligibility:</u> To be scored for the event, the following is applicable:

- a. A currently Active, Life, Junior, Club or Family Member must be on board, but not necessarily be the helmsman. Associate members who are also Family or Junior members are also eligible to fulfill this requirement.
- b. The same helmsman shall handle the helm of a given Flying Scot® through all races of the series except that he/she may have the crew handle the helm while making adjustments or handling the spinnaker, including setting, flying and dousing the spinnaker.

<u>Preregistration</u> is required. To register, please email a completed copy of the attached registration form to one of the contacts listed below prior to October 1, 2022 to avoid the late fee. Sailing Instructions will be available to registrants at the registration table on October 8, 2022.

<u>Fees</u>: Registration fee is \$80, if you register on or before October 1, 2022. From October 2 until the day of the regatta the fee is \$100. Preferred method of payment is PayPal (<u>sailcashcyc@gmail.com</u> as a friend) at the time of registration. We can also accept check or cash at the event. The fee covers the skipper and one crew member for dinner, beverages and snacks. Additional crew and guests fee is \$15 pp. We will have portable snacks available on both days, but plan on eating breakfast before arriving and bring lunch if you want a bigger meal on the water.

Notes to visiting skippers:

Candlewood Yacht Club is located in a private community. Please be considerate of our neighbors by following the speed limits. There are speed bumps on the private roads, so go slowly over them! At the club, we have a single boat ramp for launching and a fixed yard arm with chain hoist for those needing to remove bottom covers. We have set hours on Friday evening and Saturday morning for boat preparation and will have CYC members available to help as needed. Please contact us with any additional questions.

<u>Measurement</u>: Boats and sails must conform to the Official Plan. Each boat must carry equipment required by FSSA Specification Article S-V.2 (Racing Restrictions), and US Coast Guard requirements.

Courses to be Sailed: The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

<u>Radio Communication:</u> The race committee may use VHF radios (Channel 68) to communicate with competitors while racing. See Class Rules, Article S-V - Racing Restrictions, Paragraph 7 for more information regarding electronic equipment.

<u>Berthing:</u> Both Dock Slips and Dry Sail berths are available for guest boats.

Scoring: The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used, except that there will be no throw-outs. For the CT Cup, the first and last race of the regatta will be used for scoring. The boats eligible are from the three CT Flying Scot Fleets, 24, 142 and 177. The Fleet 24 Championship is only for boats in Fleet 24.

<u>Prizes</u>: Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in the Regatta.
