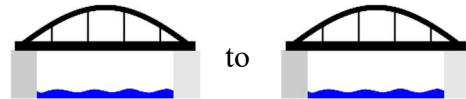
08:00 Watts Bay dry mooring area is open all day at least until sunset. Come early; warm up sailing is OK. Please call if post sunset arrival is anticipated.
