

NOTICE OF RACE

The Milwaukee Yacht Club 1700 N. Lincoln Memorial Drive Milwaukee, WI 53202

1.1 **The Milwaukee Bay One Design Championship** will be a Multi-Class Championship designated for each one-design class that has a minimum of 4 boats entered. The regatta will be held at The Milwaukee Yacht Club on September 12th and 13th, 2015.

All racing will occur in the near shore area adjacent to McKinley Marina and The Milwaukee Yacht Club. All on-shore and social activities will occur on the grounds of The Milwaukee Yacht Club located at 1700 North Lincoln Memorial Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53202.

This event shall be governed by the rules, as defined, in the current US Sailing Rules of Racing. Any changes or modifications to those rules will be as described in the Sailing Instructions to be published on or about September 1, 2015. Those instructions will be available at www.milwaukeeyc.com/regattas.

1.2 No other documents or rules shall govern this regatta.

1.3 CLASSES

This regatta is open to the following **one-design** classes. All scoring shall be based on a one-design format.

Dinghy classes including: Laser (Radial and Full rig), Club 420, 470 and Vanguard 15 (V15) **Keelboat classes including**: Soling, J/80 and J/24

Any other OD class recognized by the Milwaukee Yacht Club for this event before June 1, 2015.

The Organizing Authority has the option of eliminating any class that fails to meet the minimum number of registered boats by September 9, 2015. All fees paid, by that date, shall be refunded in full to the original registrant and the registrant will be notified in a timely manner by the Organizing Authority.

1.4 SCHEDULE

REGISTRATION: On-line registration will be available from June 1, 2015 through noon on September 11, 2015. **Registration will close at noon on September 11, 2015. THERE WILL BE NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION**. On-site check in will be available on September 11, 2015 from 1400 PM until 1800 PM and on September 12, 2014 from 0800 AM until 0900 AM. Check in will close at 0900 AM on September 12, 2015. **Any boat not checked in by 0900 AM on September 12, 2015 shall not be scored.**

RACING: Saturday September 12, 2015 and Sunday September 13, 2015 **SKIPPERS' MEETING:** 0930 AM Saturday on the patio at The Milwaukee Yacht Club **FIRST WARNING:** 1100 AM (No starting signal after 1430 hrs. on either day) **AWARDS:** Awards will be presented as soon as possible after completion of the last race on the final day of the regatta.

All fees are to be made payable to The Milwaukee Yacht. Registration must be completed on-line at www.milwaukeeyc.com/regattas. Members of The Milwaukee Yacht Club may charge the registration fee to their club account.

1.6 INSPECTION/MEASUREMENT:

No measurement or weigh-in shall be required.

1.7 COMMUNICATION:

Race Committee will **NOT** provide any courtesy announcements on-the-water. All on-the-water communication shall be through visual signals from the race committee signal boat(s).

VHF radios will be permitted on all boats, regardless of specific class rules against the use of those devices.

1.8 COURSES:

It is anticipated that there will be 2 racing circles; one for dinghy's and one for keelboats. It is further anticipated that all courses within those circles will generally be Windward/Leeward (W) courses. The Race Committee will have the option of changing the last race of each day to a Triangle (T) Course, if it so chooses. Specific details regarding the courses will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

1.9 PROTESTS:

Any protest by a competitor must be conveyed to the Race Committee, on-the-water, at the end of the race that the incident occurred in. Once ashore, the protestor **MUST** complete a US Sailing protest form, located in the office of The Milwaukee Yacht Club within 1 (one) hour of the posted dock time of the Race Committee Signal boat. Any protest filed after that time will be disallowed.

1.10 PRIZES:

Flags will be awarded to the top three boats in each of the one-design classes where at least 4 boats have registered. The 470 Lake Michigan Championship trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the 470 class.

1.11 SOCIAL EVENTS

An open party will be held on Saturday shortly after racing has been completed and all competitors have returned to the club grounds. More details on this are available at www.milwaukeeyc.com/regattas.
