- 1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the current edition of the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- Eligibility: a. A currently Active, Life, Junior, Club or family Member must be on board, but not necessarily the helmsman. Associate members who are Family or Junior members are also eligible to fulfill this requirement. b. For invitational events the same helmsman shall handle the helm of a given Flying Scot through all races of the series except that he/she may have the crew take the helm while making adjustments or handling the spinnaker, including setting, flying and dousing the spinnaker.
- 3. <u>Registration</u>: May be made by mail, email by using the attached form or may be completed at the regatta site. Fees must be paid before racing.
- 4. Fees: See Registration Form
- 5. Schedule: Sat. 9:00am Registration and continental breakfast
 - 10:00 Skippers Meeting
 - 11:30 1st race warning
 - 1:00 Lunch
 - 2:30 2nd race warning w/3rd race to follow if possible
 - 5:00 Happy Hour and Awards
 - 6:30 Dinner
- 6. <u>Measurement</u>: Boats and Sails must conform to the Official Plan. Each boat must carry equipment required by FSSA Specification Article S-V.2 (Racing Restrictions), to include: Class Anchor, Paddle, Throwable, Bailer, and Whistle.
- 7. Courses to be Sailed: The courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward and will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 8. **Scoring:** The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used, except that there will be no throw-outs. 3 races are scheduled, of which1 must be completed to constitute a series.
- 9. **Prizes**: Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats.
